Engine Rules:

All Open Sportsman Cars are eligible to compete, Top-3 WILL BE TECHED. One 4412 2bbl unaltered carburetor only. ALL CARBURETORS MUST PASS NES GAUGES TO BE LEGAL! Carburetors can be inspected prior to race day. Contact NES tech officials for inspection.

Weights:

Steel Wheels – 2,400lbs

Aluminum Wheels – 2,450lbs

*All weights are track scale pounds; weights are taken post-race, with the driver in the car

Tire Options (must be purpose-build dirt Modified tire – no specialty or Late Model tires):

Right-Rear: American Racer 48 or Harder or Hoosier D300 (any track/series stamp)

Left-Rear: American Racer 44 or Harder or Hoosier D300 (any track/series stamp)

Right-Front: American Racer 33 or Harder or Hoosier D300 (any track/series stamp)

Left-Front: American Racer 33 or Harder or Hoosier D300 (any track/series stamp)

Body Rules:

All cars must run windows, NO SAIL PANELS ARE PERMITTED. ALL Saturday night body rules apply.

Qualifying: Heat-race lineups will be determined via a draw for position. Top qualifiers will transfer to the redraw; other remaining qualifiers go to the main event. Consolations, with top finishers transferring, will set the remainder of the 24-car field. Heats are 8 Laps w/ Consolations being 10 Laps. 24 CARS WILL START THE FEATURE.

General Rules:

Safety Rules MUST Follow the NJSP & New Egypt Speedway Rule Book

One-way radios are mandatory. The frequency is 454.000.

Transponders are required for this event.
